Can walk from the house. Bar is to the left side of the hotel. Outdoor seating. Food. No need to book usually. Relaxed atmosphere. Indoor ball-pool activity area for younger children.

Walk or drive from house. Book for a table.

Booking required for restaurant – book well in advance! Check for rules on children dining. Outside bar, just turn up, dogs and children welcome. Sunday evening BBQ and live entertainment good – just turn up (holiday season). See FB page for details of opening.

Good dog-friendly reviews. Outdoor seating. A short drive from the cottage.

Ty Coch Inn LL53 6DB 01758720498

This famous beach bar cannot be accessed by road.

Ty Coch Inn LL53 6DB 01758 720498

Former 19th-c vicarage in idyllic location right on the beach with wonderful views can only be reached on foot. From the cottage it is possible to walk – takes about 30 minutes. It can get very busy at holiday times.

To get there -

Walk down the road, past the pub, over the bridge and up the hill. As you come to the bend in the road, take the public footpath through a gate on the left. Walk straight through a field (sometimes livestock), over the farm path into the next field and straight through to the golf club. Here take a left down the path through the golf course. The pub can be found near the end of the path and is signposted. You might like to walk along the beach on your return, going from Morfa Nefyn and back to Edern along the roadside. Note that at high tide, the route back can get a little muddy in places. It is possible to take the car for part of the way – the golf club offer an additional car park in high season (fee) near the golf club. LL53 6DA

Alternatively you could park in the Porthdinllaen National Trust car park LL53 6DA and walk down to Morfa Nefyn beach, then follow the bay to the left, all the way round to the pub at the far end. Opening times vary and depend on the weather/tide/season. See their FB page for details. Remember to check opening times before setting off.

<u>Takeaways</u>

<u>Gwen's Chippy LL53 6AL</u>

Closest to the house, 5 mins drive away, on road towards Pwlhelli on right hand side. Very popular – can have queues down the street. Not open Sun and Mon. Closes at 8pm weekdays and 9pm Fri and Sat.

Nefyn Kebab and Pizza House LL53 6HD

10 minutes drive away. Great for kebabs, pizza, burgers etc, very popular, can get busy.

In Pwlhelli, really good quality but a bit of a drive from the house. Good if you are on your way back from Portmadog/ Criccieth etc.

<u>Close to the House</u>

Little shop in the village Just down the road from the cottage. Sells basic food, fresh veg, superb meat and some frozen food. Fresh farm produce available daily.

Petrol Station Morfa Nefyn. Has a small supermarket, bakery and fresh meat counter. Also good for home-produced ready meals such as pizza, pasta and Sunday roasts!

<u>Spar</u> LL53 6ND Nefyn is a slightly bigger supermarket, with a better range. Fantastic meat from local farms.

<u>Asda LL53 5HY</u> Pwllheli Much bigger supermarket. Other Shops

<u>DIY</u> <u>DIY Shed LL53 6AP</u> Near the petrol station in Morfa Nefyn. Stocks wood and firelighters for the wood-burner. Great for a variety of things. Also sells buckets and spades, body boards and beach items.

Dog Friendly Beaches

Morfa Nefyn - Use Porthdinllaen NT Car Park - LL53 6YN Walking distance from the house - walk down the road, past the pub, up the hill. Take the first turn on the left along Lon Las. Cross the road at the crossroads, along Lon Bridin. This road leads down to the slipway. Dogs are allowed to the left of the slipway. You can follow the beach to the left to get to the Ty Coch Inn.

Abersoch Village Hall Car Park LL53 7EA This car park easy for town centre, harbour (good crabbing) and small beach. Get there early for parking – gets very busy.

Abersoch Beach Car Park LL53 7EY For big beach. Gets very busy. No dogs between the jetty and river mouth.

LLanbedrog LL53 7TR Dog-friendly to your right as you go down the slip. Can go to the left, but must be on a lead past the beach huts. Gorgeous beach, soft sand.

<u>Pwllheli</u> LL53 5HG</u> For town centre, amusements, shops, Weatherspoons etc LL53 5YT For Marina LL53 5AB For Beach

<u>Criccieth LL52 OHP</u> Picturesque. Beach, town centre, food, castle. (Dog-friendly part of the beach is the eastern end of the beach beyond the car park.) Dolphins can be seen occasionally from this beach! Don't follow SAT NAV – take the coast road from Pwllheli – much nicer views along the coast road.

Black Rock Sands LL49 9YB Drive onto beach ** <u>Take care to keep an eye on the tide</u>** Massive beach, toilets, ice cream etc. Good for a picnic. Take chairs, beach games etc.

Harlech LL44 2YH For castle and village centre.

<u>Harlech Beach LL46 2 UG</u> For beach. Gorgeous massive white sand beach. Good for picnic and beach games. Dogs able to walk all year round on the left side of the beach.

<u>Nant Gwytheryrn LL53 6NL</u> Good for a short visit. National Welsh Language and Heritage Centre. Spectacular views, especially on approach road – hairpin bends, single track in places. Fantastic café and outdoor seating. Very steep path down to the beach.

<u>Aberdaron LL53 8BW</u> Good for a short visit. Fantastic Fish and Chip shop 'Sblash'. NT car park. Good range of dog-friendly pubs, some with tables overlooking the beach. Ty Newydd Pub with beer garden close by.

Hell's Mouth Beach (Porth Neigwl) LL53 7LR Massive beach, popular with surfers, gets a great sunset. No facilities.

Porthmadog LL49 9EH Harbour, shops, cafes etc. Great for wandering round the shops. Fabulous café upstairs in the Portmeirion shop by the big roundabout. (No dogs) Good crabbing to be had at the harbour. Dog-friendly café in the square by the harbour. Welsh Highland Heritage Railway (LL49 9DY).

Nefyn Beach LL53 6ED Great for an early morning or evening walk with the dog. In Summer, dogs are only allowed to the right of the slipway. Car park is VERY small, but can park on the main road and walk down. New café that sells dog ice cream, bakery items and beach toys. Great beach for cricket when the tide is out.
